Thanks to everyone who participated in our 2017 Open NRA Air Sectional and our Open 3-Position Metric Matches. Once again we had a great match turnout this year. We had 41 air rifle competitors and 28 smallbore rifle competitors compared to 34 air rifle and 25 smallbore competitors last year. Our best year for this event was 2015 when we had 41 air rifle and 29 smallbore competitors. Attendance continues to be excellent for our air rifle and smallbore rifle events in North Dakota.

As usual, the tough competition in this northern country brings up everyone's scores.

# We have 3 more events at our range this year including a <u>50 yard</u> NRA Open Regional Smallbore Rifle Championship on February 25 and 26. This is a 120 shot any sight match. The match can be fired on either day. This is a great event – put it on your schedule.

The North Dakota Junior 4-Position Smallbore Rifle State Championship and NRA Junior Sectional matches will be the weekend of March 11 and 12, 2017. Anyone can fire in our State Championship, however, the high North Dakota resident will be recognized as the State Champion. Finally, we will have our Junior Club championship on Saturday, March 19. This will be a conventional 4-Position 40-shot event. Awards will be provided to the top shooter, and class winners from the Bismarck/Mandan R&P Association. Juniors from other clubs are invited. Winners from other clubs will be recognized with certificates.

The North Dakota Shooting Sports Association (NDSSA) annual convention is in Bismarck the weekend of January 27, 28 and 29, 2017, at the Eagles Club and at our range. We will recognize 2016 state champions and 2016 state records (including Junior competitors) at the Saturday night banquet. We will also induct long time High Power Rifle Competitor - Norm Weber – into the North Dakota Shooting Sports Hall of Fame. Our keynote speaker will be 3 time Olympian – Jason Turner. Jason should have a great message – especially for the younger competitors. The NDSSA annual membership meeting will be Saturday afternoon. I've been involved in the shooting sports for many years and anytime you get an opportunity to attend a clinic such as this, even if it is not in your shooting sports discipline – I strongly encourage you to attend - these guys have traveled the world in the shooting sports and they always have a great message in addition to the technical aspects of the sport.
